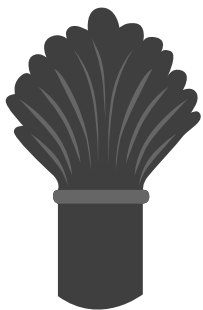
Flora

Fauna

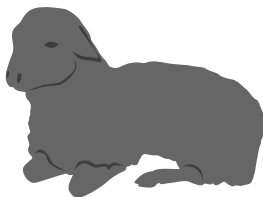
Animals and Birds
